### NEW COMMUNITY HEALTH PLAN AVAILABLE

For several years the community and the WCHC board have encouraged the WCHC to have a prepaid medical plan (like the Kaleo plan) available for people receiving care at the WCHC. Such a plan is now available and it is called the Community Health Program (CHP). It is provided through the Hawaii Medical Services Association (HMSA).

The plan includes preventive services as well as treatment of illness. At the present time, the plan is available only through an employer. In other words, a person may not sign up for the program at the WCHC on an individual basis, but only through an employer group.

CHP has been available since December 1, 1978. The goal of CHP is to provide quality care at a reasonable cost. If you have any questions about CHP, please call HMSA at 744-2171.
