BEWARE: City & County Requires Health Center Driveway Change

"DO NOT ENTER" is the sign that now greets everyone who comes up the first driveway to the Health Center. The driveway is now the entrance **for emergency vehicles only but the exit for all vehicles**. Why the change? The City and County is requiring the change to prevent a backup of cars wanting to turn left up to the Health Center from Mailiilii Road. All vehicles must use the back driveway up to the Health Center during normal clinic hours on weekdays and Saturdays. When clinics are closed, the back driveway gate will be chained. During those times only, vehicles may use the emergency entrance. We appreciate the communities understanding and support of this change.

Parking Concerns Addressed

Over the last few years, the Health Center has been just as frustrated as patients and Dining Pavilion patrons with the lack of parking at its main campus. For the last month, there have been dramatic changes to the availability of parking. New designated staff parking areas has opened up more parking for patients and Dining Pavilion patrons.
